- *1. Thermo-Friendly Concept: An M-E-I-K (Mechanics Electronics IT Knowledge creation) solution that achieves highly accurate machining even in factory environments where ambient temperatures change. Based on innovative machine designs that "don't fight" temperature changes, we have achieved highly accurate stability without requiring special air conditioning systems, by fusing our unique control and information processing technologies with the expertise of thermal displacement analysis cultivated over many years. We have shipped more than 50,000 exceptionally reliable machines.
- *2. ECO suite: A machine conditions management solution that stops peripheral equipment, coolers, and more when wasteful processes are not necessary, while maintaining the required accuracies. The machine itself decides whether cooling is needed or not and saves energy by reducing standby and operating power consumption.
- * TCFD (Task Force on Climate-related Financial Disclosures): A task force established in December 2015 by the Financial Stability Board (FSB) to improve and increase reporting of climate-related financial information. The final TCFD report was published in June 2017, encouraging companies to disclose information on climate change risks.
